The UC level stakeholders' seminar was conducted on Monday 16th July at the Social Welfare Office Kuchlak.

The purpose of conducting the seminar was to further build on the relationship between all the stakeholders' involved in the Quetta Urban Development Programme under RAHA.

The seminar was started by welcome remarks to the participants and with introduction to the project. All the stakeholders present were briefed about the project activities. The forum was told about various activities such as health and hygiene sessions, debate competitions, construction of garbage collection points, celebration of World Environment Day and the objectives of the RAHA programme.

Afterwards, representatives from all the stakeholders' present were invited to address the forum and express their views and suggestions to improve the implementation of the project and its outputs.

All the participants discussed that the efforts taken under this RAHA programme had been required for a long time but nothing at all had been done about the matter. Instance shared repeatedly was the large heaps of garbage lying in the city which were cause of disease and discomfort.

The speakers told the forum that the garbage in the city had become a hallmark by which the city is being recognized in other parts of the province. All participants promised maximum support in the implementation of the project.



The participants made following recommendations to be considered within the implantation of this project and other similar projects in the future;

1. The design of the collection points can be reconsidered as it seems to be a difficult task to remove the garbage from the points;
2. Considering the population of the union council, the approved number of collection points do not cater to the needs of all the people;
3. There is a need for similar

Projects in other villages of the union council Kuchlak;

4. The formed Community Organizations need to make sure that they fulfill their responsibilities after the completion of the project and supervise removal of garbage from the collection points on regular basis;
5. The speakers also expressed the need of projects in other sectors especially education.

Overall the seminar was success in bringing the stakeholders' on one forum and served as an eye-opener about the problems caused by the garbage lying in the city.

As far as the design of the collection points is concerned,

the forum agreed that the collection points will be filled and evacuated on the standard design for a period of one month and if the problem with the removal of the garbage remained, further modifications, related to the removal of a part of the front wall, will be discussed.
